Free House Cleaning Check List

The Kitchen - The cleaning tasks (jobs) which should be done in the kitchen include:

- washing the dishes
- cleaning the kitchen bench and tabletop
- emptying and washing the kitchen rubbish bin
- sweeping and/or washing (mopping) the floor
- wiping the shelves and cleaning the cupboards, inside and out
- cleaning the stove oven and range hood
- cleaning out the refrigerator
- cleaning the walls, windows and brushing fly screens
- cleaning the door handles and light switches
- removing cobwebs

The Bathroom - The cleaning jobs which should be done in the bathroom include:

- cleaning the hand basin, shower recess and/or bath
- sweeping and washing (mopping) the floor
- cleaning the mirror, cupboards and/or shelves
- changing or washing the towels and the bathmat
- cleaning the walls and windows and brushing fly screens
- removing cobwebs

The Laundry and Toilet - The cleaning jobs which should be done in the laundry and toilet include:

- washing clothes, linen (for example, towels, sheets) and blankets
- sweeping and washing (mopping) the floor
- cleaning the tub and washing machine
- cleaning the cupboards, walls and windows and brushing fly screens
- cleaning the toilet
- cleaning the door handles and light switches
- removing cobwebs

Bedrooms - The cleaning jobs which should be done in bedrooms include:

- sweeping, vacuuming and/or washing the floors
- dusting the shelves and cleaning cupboards
- cleaning walls and windows and brushing flyscreens
- cleaning the door handles and light switches
- removing cobwebs
- changing the sheets on the bed and airing (putting in the sun for a few hours) the blankets and mattresses

Living Rooms and Veranda - The cleaning jobs which should be done in living rooms and verandas include:

- sweeping and/or washing (mopping) the floors, including the veranda
- dusting the shelves and cleaning out cupboards
- cleaning the door handles and light switches
- cleaning the walls and windows and brushing fly screens
- removing cobwebs

How often the various parts of a house need to be cleaned depends upon:

- how many people live in the house
- how many other people use the house
- how many pets belong to the household etc.
